To draw the learners' interest towards artistic works, the **Theme based Display board/Wall magazine** activity was conducted for the month of **June** 2021.








BHASHA SANGAM

 21^{st} , 23^{rd} , 25^{th} and 28^{th} of June 2021.









Online mode.









Monthly Community Song -(Sare jahan se achha)


