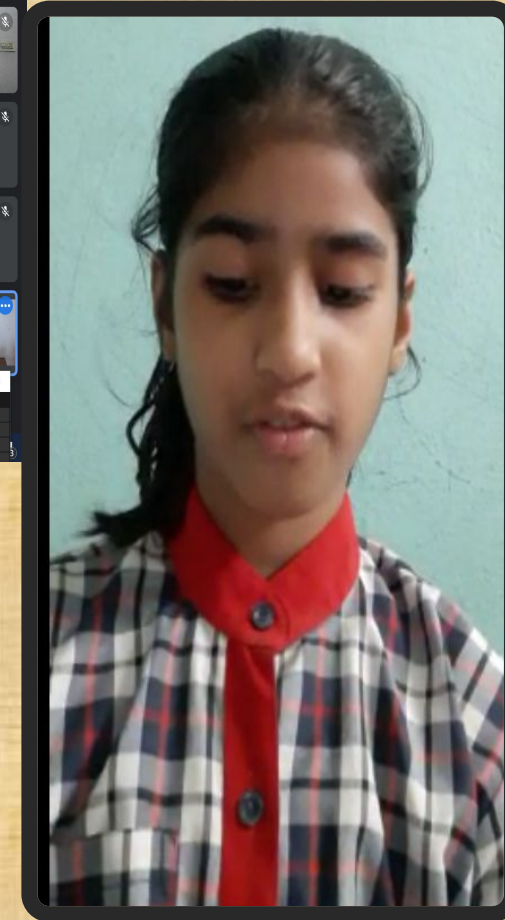

To draw the learners' interest towards artistic works, the **Theme based Display board/Wall magazine** activity was conducted for the month of **June 2021**.

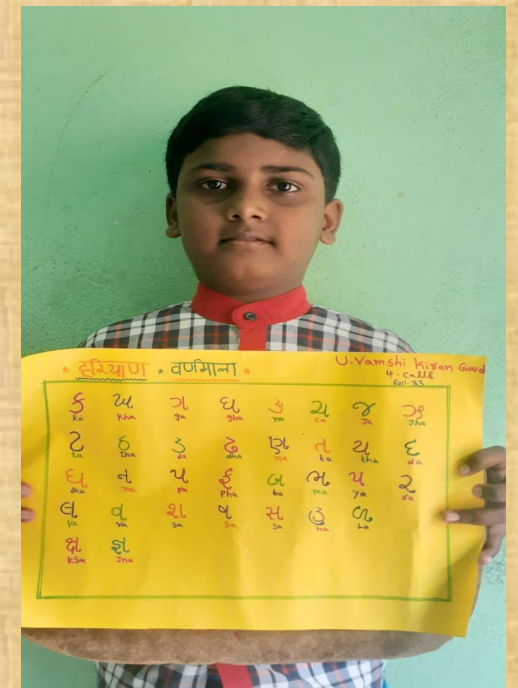
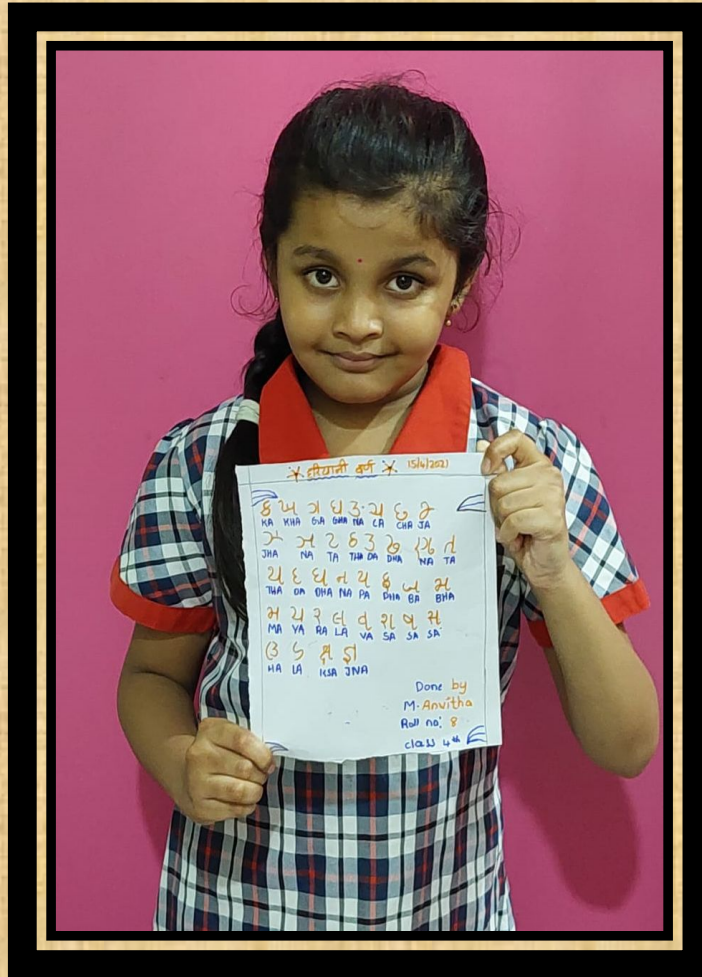

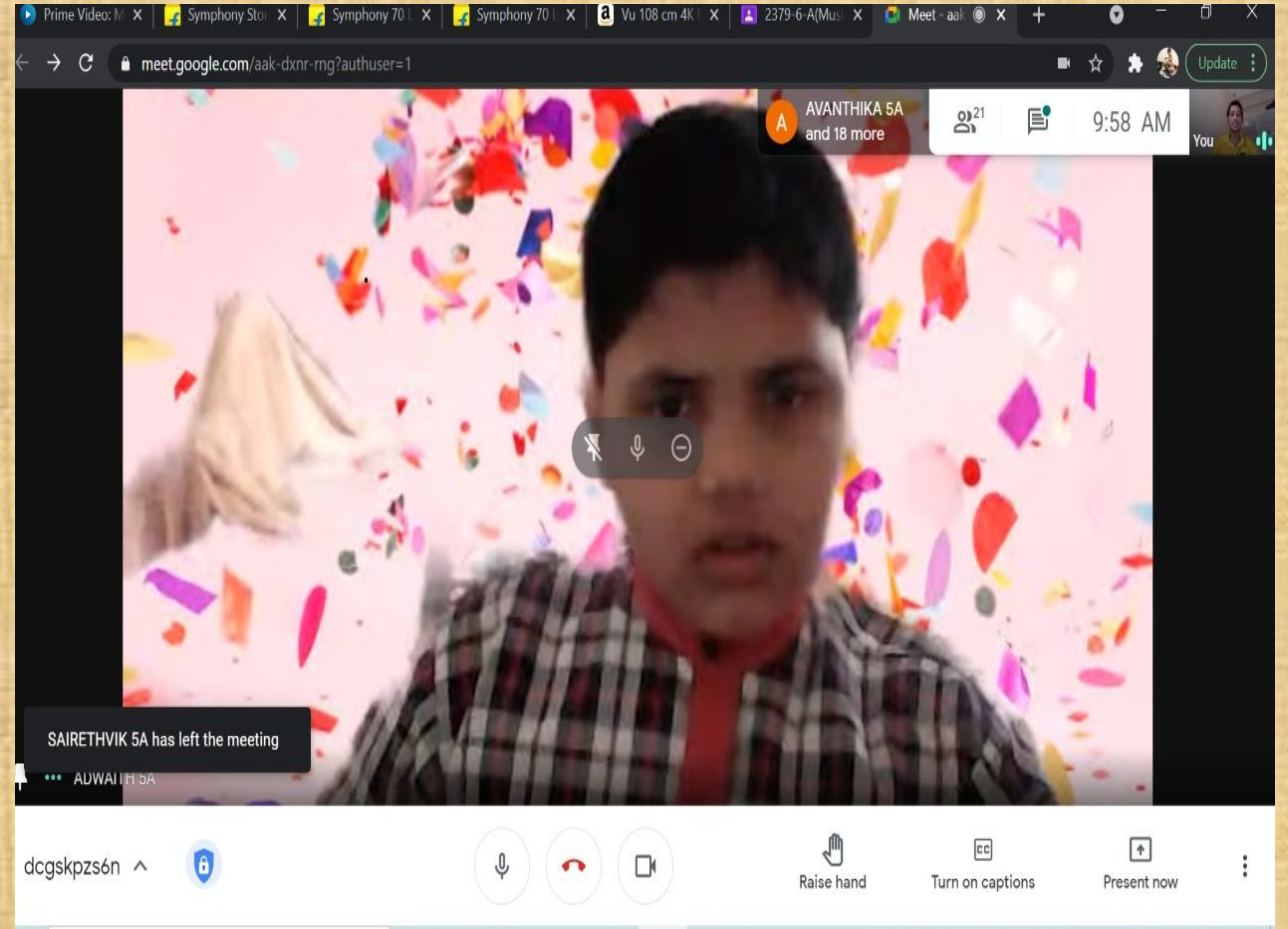
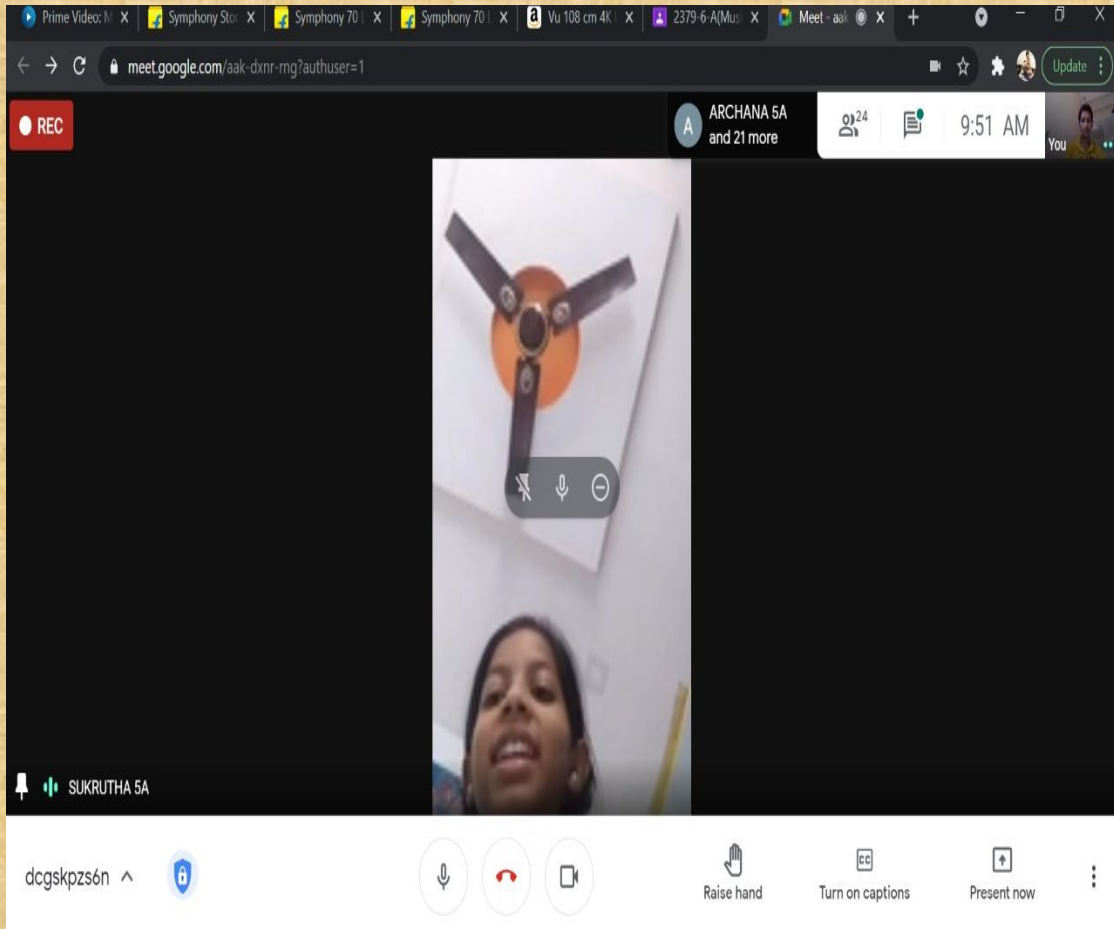


Monthly Community Song – (*Sare jahan se achha*)

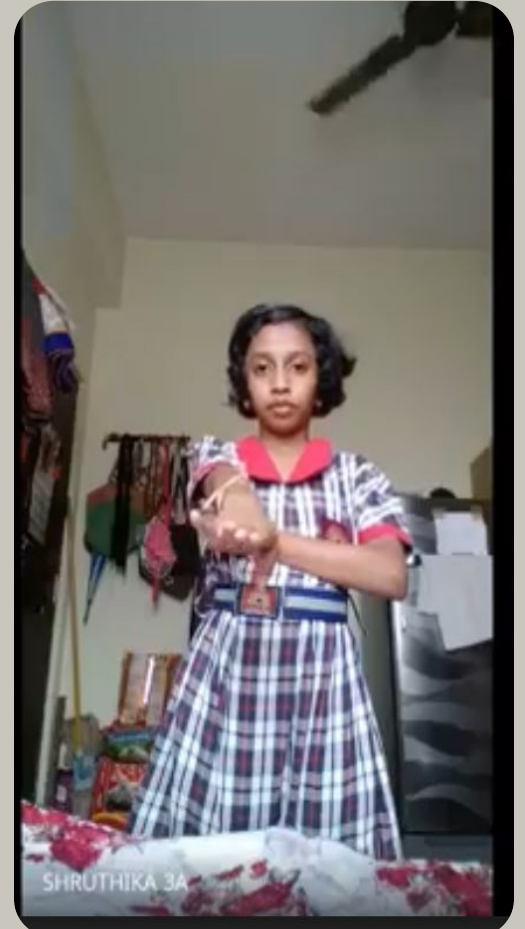

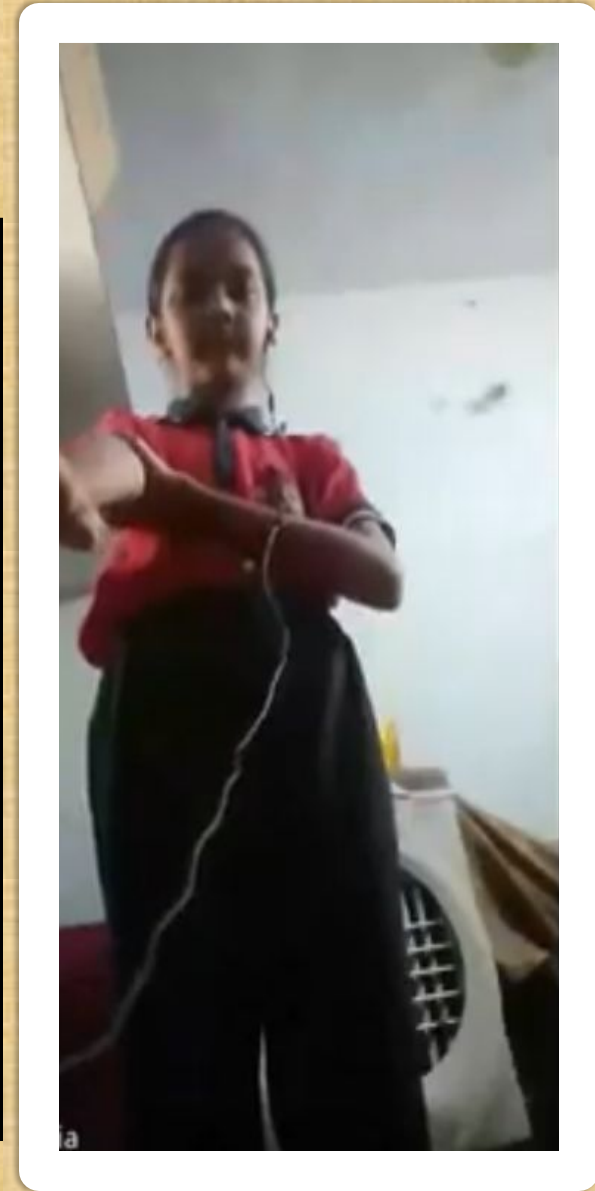
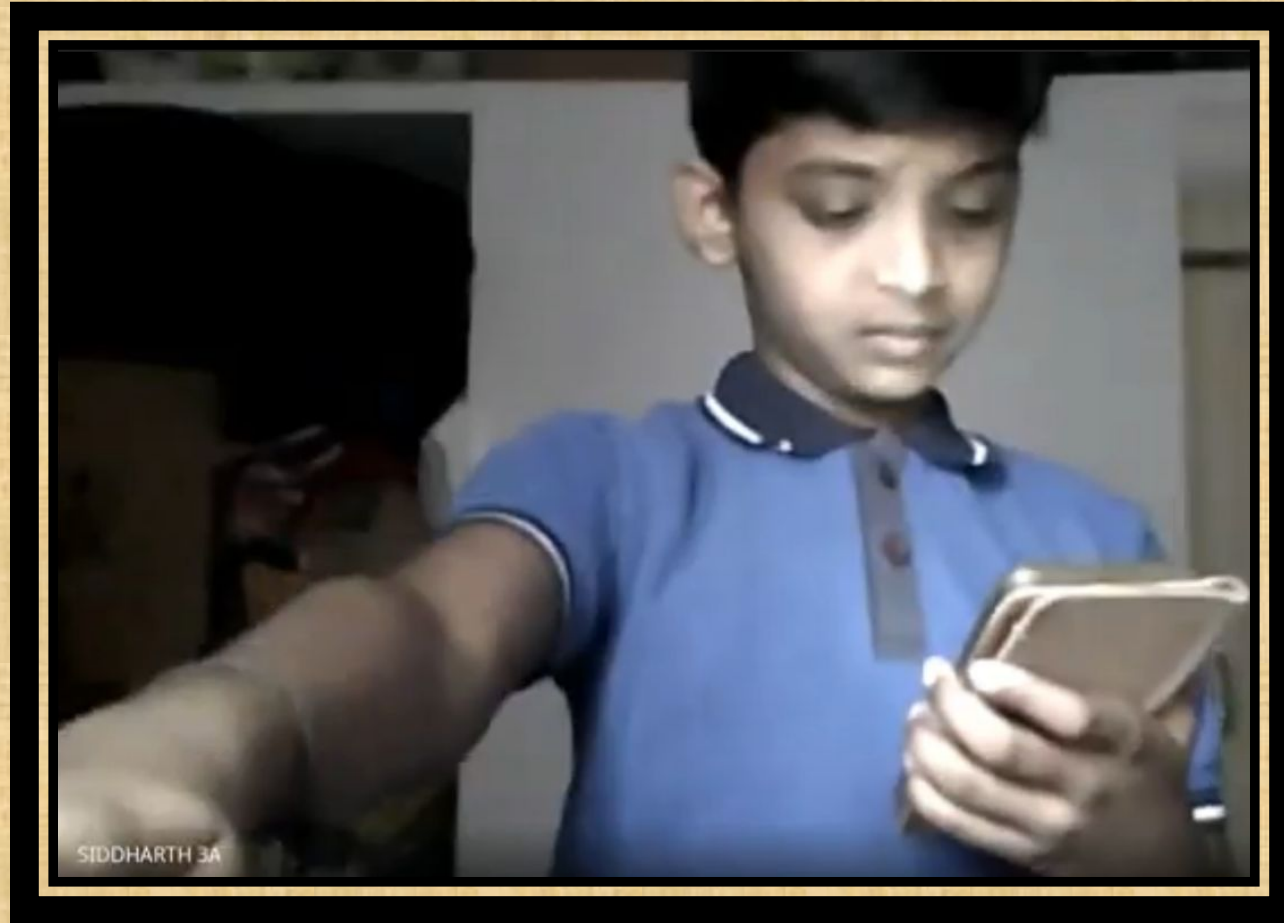


Swachhhta Pledge
